

## ASSOCIATION OF BRITISH RIDING SCHOOLS EQUESTRIAN CARE AWARD NOTES FOR CANDIDATES

These tests are designed for riders who wish to help out with lessons at their riding school. Unlike the progressive rider tests in Equitation and Stable Management they are based on a log book and will be tested in-house by a member of staff over a period of time. There is no time limit for completion.

The contents of the log books are designed to encourage young helpers to develop increasing competence in assisting before, during and after lessons and a growing awareness of Health and Safety around the yard.

## There are 3 levels of tests:

Entry minimum age 10

Intermediate minimum age 12

Senior minimum age 14

The cost of training will vary from school to school. On completion each logbook will be submitted to the ABRS Head Office with a fee of £15. The candidate will receive an A4 certificate and a record of their success will be kept in ABRS files.
